- Perform detailed medication reconciliation across prescription, over the counter and supplement lists to streamline care; identify drug-drug interactions and eliminate duplicate therapies.
- Support remote monitoring of patients by checking labs, blood pressure, heart rate and following up on medication titration.
- Support the clinical team in dosing outpatient IV diuresis and oral loop diuretic dose adjustments to prevent avoidable hospitalizations.
- Lead the submission, follow-up, and appeals process for Prior Authorizations to reduce delays in therapy.
- Proactively identify and assist patients with Medication Assistance Programs (PAPs), co-pay cards, grants, and manufacturer support to remove financial barriers to care.
- Coordinate directly with retail, specialty, and mail-order pharmacies to resolve denials,

delays, and access obstacles.

- Provide high-touch counseling to patients and caregivers on medication purpose, administration techniques, potential side effects, and "red flag" warning signs.
- Implement strategies to monitor and improve medication adherence, identifying non-clinical barriers to compliance.
- Ensure meticulous documentation of all interventions and communications within the EHR to maintain a seamless "gold standard" of care.
- Assist with tracking high-risk patient cohorts to ensure timely lab follow-ups and therapy adjustments, closing gaps in evidence-based care.
